

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

**What does it cost?** \$35 Registration, which includes all activity fees and meals. Youth Workers will be charged \$20. We will provide all meals from Thursday supper through Saturday breakfast if you lodge with us. If you provide your own lodging, you will be on your own for breakfast.

**What are the dates and times?** Youth Conference registration begins at 10:00 on Thursday morning, April 30<sup>th</sup>. The first service will begin at 1:00 p.m. The conference ends at noon on Saturday, May, 2<sup>nd</sup>. Please plan on arriving by 12:30 so that we can begin at 1:00 p.m. We will have maps of Barrie for those that would like to register in the morning and then go somewhere until we begin at 1:00.

**What about lodging?** Lodging will be provided in the homes of our church members if you have requested it by April 22<sup>nd</sup>. We will need to know how many teens and workers will need lodging. You should bring your own towels and a sleeping bag in case they are needed.

**Who can attend the Youth Conference?** Any young person in the sixth grade through those teens that are one year out of high school may attend. We ask that you not bring children to the daytime sessions unless you are prepared to watch them yourself in our nursery. Nursery will be available for the evening services. Every group present should have at least one adult present. Please feel free to call if you have any questions.

**When and how should I register?** You may register upon arrival on April 30<sup>th</sup>. If you can get your registration in earlier, it will help us in taking care of your group when you arrive. You may send one check to cover the entire group. Even if you are not going to register early, please let us know by April 22<sup>nd</sup> how many are coming. You may bring more workers or teens, but as much as possible, please let us know who and how many are coming.

**What should I wear?** **Youth Workers, please make sure your teens know this before they come.**

**Young Ladies** should wear modest, loose fitting culottes, skirts or dresses for all services and activities. These must be at least knee length. We ask that slits not be any higher than the knee. No pants. Nice dresses should be worn in the evening services. **Young Men** should wear collared shirts or dress clothes in the services. T-shirts may be worn for activities, but should not contain questionable pictures or emblems. No shorts.
